

Orban: Europe's Energy Crisis Due to EU Climate Change Actions

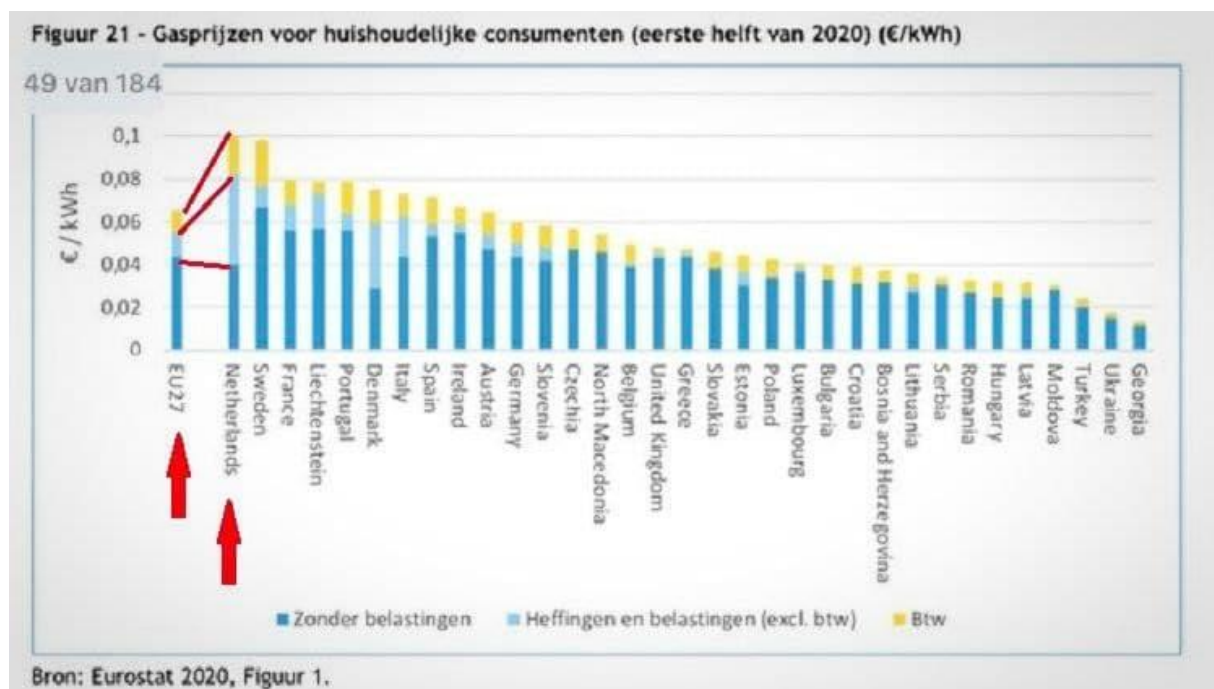
Hungarian PM Viktor Orban has BLAMED EU action to combat climate change for the surge in energy prices and stated Poland, Czechia and Hungary would present a united front at the next bloc summit.

Orban told state radio on Friday that "bureaucrats in Brussels" are countering climate change by continuously raising the price of energy from coal and gas leading to a spike in household energy bills across Europe.

"These [EU] decisions must be withdrawn [...] at present gas prices are where they should be in 2035. Brussels is not the solution today; they are the problem. Poles, Czech and we Hungarians demand that the rules should be withdrawn."
